TOMBALL CITY COUNCIL APPROVES MUSEUM MASTER PLAN

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

TOMBALL, TEXAS (JAN. 17, 2017): Tomball City Council gave the green light to development of the Texas Railroading Heritage Museum at Tomball at its meeting on Monday, Jan. 16, 2017. Approval of the museum master plan sets in motion fundraising, detailed planning and construction of the museum.

The museum will be built immediately adjacent to the city's existing Railroad Depot, Plaza and Gazebo in Tomball's downtown historic district on property purchased for the purpose by the city. The site is bounded by the existing depot park to the north, the BNSF mainline to the east, McPhail St. to the south and the South Elm St. right-of-way to the west. Historic railroad passenger and freight cars, locomotives and other artifacts owned by Gulf Coast Chapter - National Railway Historical Society, Inc. will be displayed at the new museum.
